C- Conclusion

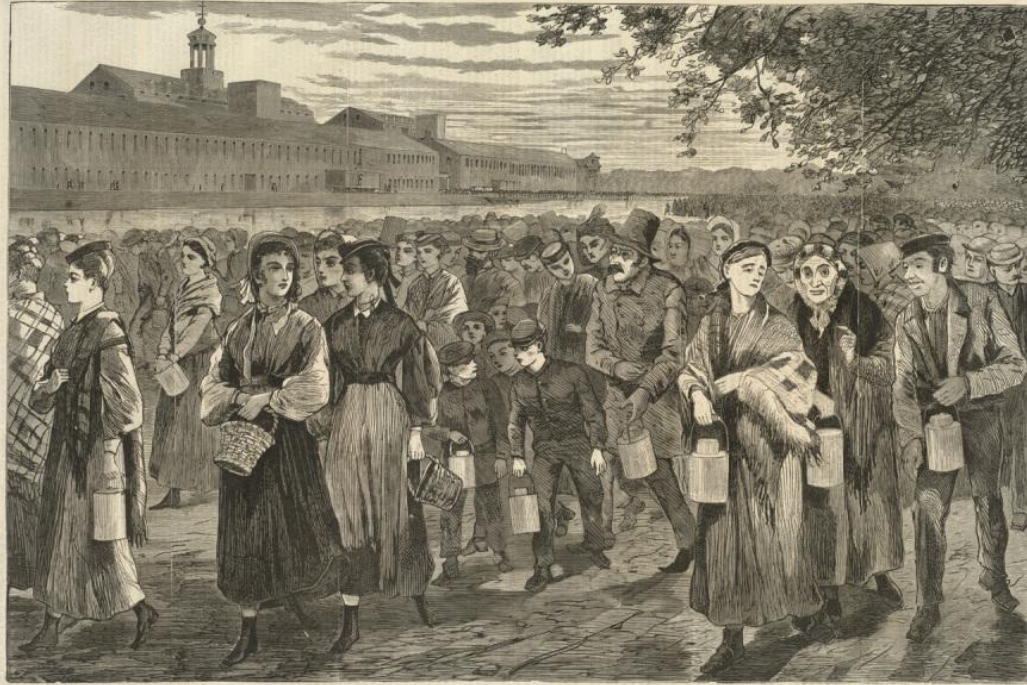

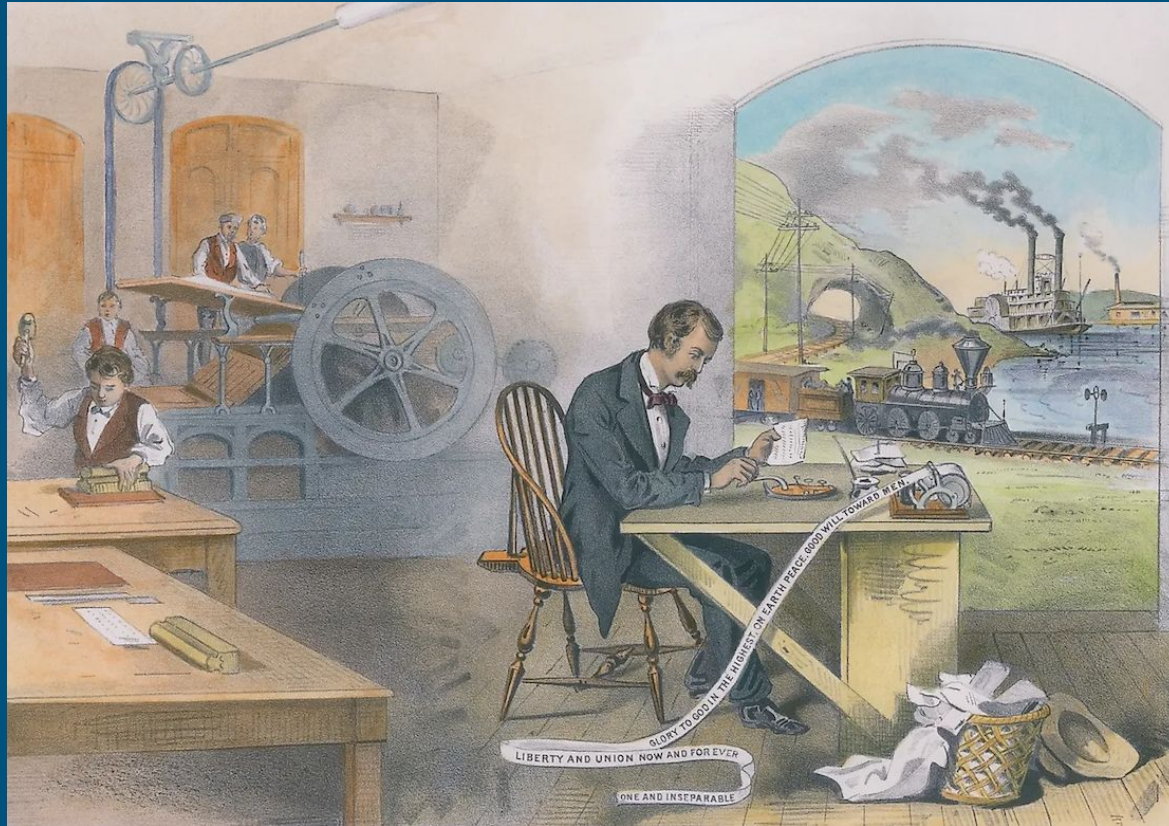
