## Contextualization

1754-1763 - The French and Indian War

1763-1775 – A series of parliamentary acts and missteps by the British government leads to war with the thirteen colonies.

1775-1783 – The Revolutionary War (1776- The Declaration of Independence)

1787- The Constitution is developed.

1789-1797– George Washington becomes our first president. His administration sets the precedent for our government under the Constitution. The nation continues its expansion into the West. A new American character develops.

1800– With the formation of political parties, Thomas Jefferson, the first political figure from a rival party becomes the president.
